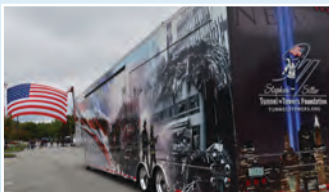
**8 SECOND RIDE**

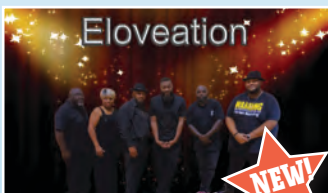
